COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 925, L.D.  
1327, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to a Grievance Procedure  
Concerning Discrimination on the Basis of Handicap."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§42-B" in  
the 3rd line (page 2, line 16 in L.D.) by striking  
out the underlined word "may" and inserting in its  
place the underlined word 'shall' and in the last  
line (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the  
underlined word "control" the following: 'except in  
cases of conflict with other federal regulations'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes it clear that the Commis-  
sioner of Human Services must create a grievance pro-  
cedure as required by federal law. It also ensures  
that state regulations adopted pursuant to federal  
laws that are more restrictive than those adopted un-  
der the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section  
42-B are not in conflict with Title 22, section 42-B.
