Whereas, the establishment of a date certain for the adjourning of the Legislature will provide the Legislators, the legislative staff, the Executive Department, the Judicial Department and the public with a clear time frame for the conduct of the business of the people; and

40 41 Whereas, the length of the legislative session is directly related to the expenditure of the public fisc and the shortening of the length of the sessions will result in a substantial savings to the public fisc, as substantial savings can be realized if this legislation is effective now; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 MRSA §2, 2nd paragraph, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 750, §1, is amended to read:

The first regular session of the Legislature, after its convening, shall adjourn no later than 100 tegistative days after its convening June 15th the 2nd regular session of the Legislature shall adjourn no later than 50 legislative days after convening April 15th. In the event that June 15th in the year of the first regular session or April 15th the year of the 2nd regular session is a Saturday or Sunday, the adjournment date for the first regular session shall be the Friday prior to June 15th the adjournment date for the 2nd regular session shall be the Friday prior to April 15th. The Legislature, in case of emergency, may by a vote of 2/3the members of each House present and voting, extend the date for adjournment for the first or 2nd regular session by no more than 5 legislative days, and case of further emergency, may by a vote of 2/3 of the members of each House present and voting, further extend the date for adjournment by 5 additional leg-

- islative days. The times for adjournment for the first and 2nd regular sessions may also be extended for one additional legislative day for the purpose of considering possible objections of the Governor to any bill or resolution presented to him by the Legislature under the Constitution, Article IV, Part Third, Section 2.
- 8 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 9 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-10 proved.

## 11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The purpose of this new draft is to establish 13 specific date by which the Legislature is required to 14 The adjournment date of the first regular 15 session is June 15th and the adjournment date of the 16 2nd regular session is April 15th. The current statu-17 tory extension dates are retained in the event that 18 additional time is necessary to complete legislative 19 work. The number of legislative days as a limit on 20 legislative sessions has been removed.
