STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This bill limits the number of clients assigned 7 to a human services caseworker. Currently, many 8 caseworkers are experiencing frustration and burnout. One of the causes of that problem is the current 9 overload of clients. This bill also requires the de-10 11 partment to report to the Governor and Legislature 12 any overload which has existed for at least 2 months 13 and to indicate any vacant caseworker positions in the region experiencing the overload. 14
