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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 943, L.D. 1353, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Correct Certain Inconsistencies Relating to Civil Offices."

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Amend the resolution in the next to the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 36 and 37 in L.D.) by striking out the words "on the date of the proclamation" and inserting in their place the following: 'upon the convening of the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature in December, 1986'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment establishes an effective date for the resolution if it is approved by the electorate at referendum. The amendment delays implementation of the resolution until the convening of the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature in December, 1986.
