14 There shall be one director of the program who 15 shall be confidential at pay range 27; one part-time 16 clerical person who shall be classified at pay range 17 8; and 2 Motivational Counselors who shall be classi-18 fied at pay range 22. All staff shall be subject to 19 the Personnel Law.'

20 Further amend the Bill by striking out all of 21 section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

22 'Sec. 2. Report. The Director of the State Employee Assistance Program and the Commissioner of Finance and Administration or his designee shall conduct a study of the program and report their findings and recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on State Government no later than January 1, 1986.

The study shall include the total number of users of the program, the number of users by departments or agencies of State Government, the methods by which the users learned about the program or came into contact with the program and alternative funding proposals for implementing the program.' In addition, this amendment re-quires the Director of the Employee Assistance Pro-4 5 gram and the Commissioner of Finance and Administra-tion to study the degree of use of the program and alternative funding mechanisms to finance implementa-6 7 8 9 tion of the program.
