26	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §7202-A is enacted to read:		
27	§7202-A. Family liaison		
28 29 30	The commissioner shall contract for the services of a person within the department to act as liaison to families with exceptional children.		
31 32 33 34 35	1. Qualifications. The family liaison shall cur- rently be, or formerly have been, the parent of an exceptional child and shall be qualified by training or experience to perform the duties required in sub- section 2.		

1 2. Duties. The family liaison shall be available 2 to meet or talk with the parents of an exceptional 3 child concerning the needs of the child and of the 4 family, the appropriate federal and state laws and 5 rules and the services available to the child and the 6 family.

7 Implementation; pilot project; report of Sec. 2. 8 the commissioner. The provisions of this Act shall be 9 implemented as a pilot project and shall terminate on 10 June 30, 1987, unless continued by act of the Legis-11 lature. The Commissioner of Educational and Cultural 12 Services shall begin implementation of this Act, in-13 cluding contracting for the family liaison, as soon 14 as practicable after the effective date of this Act 15 and shall report his experiences, findings and recom-16 mendations to the First Regular Session of the 113th 17 Legislature.

18 Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are 19 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the 20 the purposes of this Act.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this new draft is to establish a 3 pilot project providing for a family liaison within 4 the Department of Educational and Cultural Services. Currently, when parents of exceptional children par-5 6 ticipate in the pupil evaluation team process and when they assist in development of the individual ed-7 8 ucation plan for their child, they often find them-9 selves in an unfamiliar setting with an array of pro-10 fessionals who sometimes present things in technical 11 language. In those circumstances, the parents, who 12 are the ones most familiar with the educational needs 13 of their child, are often intimidated and are unable 14 to participate in the process in an appropriate way. 15 The result may be the development of an educational 16 plan that is inappropriate for the child, which frus-17 trates the child and parents and subverts the purpose 18 of the process.

19 This new draft reduces from 3 to 1 the number of 20 liaisons in the department, provides that the commis-21 sioner shall contract for the liaison services and 22 revises the fiscal note.

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
