7 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" 8 to S.P. 505, L.D. 1365, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Addi-9 tional Allocations from the Alcohol Premium Fund."

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 13 in amendment) by inserting at the beginning of the line the following: 'Sec. 1.'

14 Further amend the amendment by inserting before 15 the statement of fact the following:

16 'Sec. 2. Coordination. The Department of Corrections, the Department of Educational and Cultural 8 Services, the Department of Human Services and the 19 Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation 20 shall coordinate, to the greatest extent possible, 21 their goals, education, treatment, training, preven-22 tion and research programs.

23 Sec. 3. Accountability. The Alcohol and Drug 24 Planning Committee shall report to the Legislature on or before the first day of each regular session of 25 26 the Legislature the actions taken by the departments 27 pursuant to the allocations made from this fund. The 28 report shall include a description of each program 29 and actions taken expending funds for alcoholism prevention, training, education, treatment and research. 30 31 The funds expended shall be identified as to source, 32 whether federal, state or private grants. In addi-33 tion, the committee shall provide a report on drug 34 abuse, including a description of all programs and 35 expenditures of all funds. The reports may include 36 recommendations and outline issues which the Legisla-37 ture, departments and the committee may wish to ad-38 dress.

1 Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-2 3 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-4 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-5 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-6 ture and those reclassifications and range changes 7 which have been approved by the Department of Person-8 nel and submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of this Act. 9

10 Sec. 5. Encumbered balances at year end. At the 11 end of each fiscal year, all encumbered balances 12 shall not be carried more than once.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

14The purpose of this amendment is to add standard15language governing the coordination, accountability16and administration of alcoholism services programs.
