COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 505, L.D. 1365, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Allocations from the Alcohol Premium Fund."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Allocations of Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research Fund. Income to the Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research Fund for the period of July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, and the fiscal year of July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed. The total allocations shall be as follows:
