AN ACT Concerning Golf Course Employees as
Nonseasonal Employees Under the Employment
Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 MRSa §1251, sub-§3, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. Any golf club which customarily operates during a regularly recurring period of 26 or more weeks in a calendar year shall not be deemed seasonal.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to exclude golf clubs
3 which operate 26 or more weeks in a year from being
4 considered as seasonal industries under the Employ-
5 ment Security Law.

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
