SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 951, L.D. 1370, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand and
Continue Alcoholism Treatment, Education, Prevention
and Research Programs."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title
the following:

'Amend the bill in the first line after the en-
acting clause (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by inserting
at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment in the beginning of
the first line after the title (page 1, line 11 in
amendment) by striking out the word "Amend" and in-
serting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after
the 2nd paragraph after the title the following:

'Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §475, sub-§1, as enacted by PL
1981, c. 454, §8, is amended to read:

1. Purposes and objects. The Legislature may
make allocations from the fund to any public or pri-
vate agency or person to carry out the purposes of
this chapter. Beginning in 1987, legislation relating
to allocations from the fund shall be reviewed by the
joint standing committee of the Legislature having
jurisdiction over appropriations and financial af-
fairs. Other legislation relating to alcoholism pro-
grams shall be reviewed by the appropriate commit-
tee.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment provides that, beginning in 1987,
3 legislation relating to allocations from the Alcoholism
4 Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research
5 Fund shall be reviewed by the joint standing committee
6 of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations
7 and financial affairs and that other
8 legislation relating to alcoholism programs shall be
9 reviewed by the appropriate committee.
