SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 951, L.D. 1370, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand and
Continue Alcoholism Treatment, Education, Prevention
and Research Programs."

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything
after the title and inserting in its place the fol-
lowing:

'Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT
Concerning Alcohol Treatment, Education, Prevention
and Research Programs.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything
after the enacting clause and inserting in its place
the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §7132, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted
by PL 1983, c. 464, §19, is amended to read:

A. By January 15, 1984, and each year thereaf-
ter, a report containing an evaluation of the
past year's progress toward obtaining established
goals and objectives and the planning committee's
recommendations regarding allocations from the
Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and
Research Fund appropriations from the General
Fund for alcoholism programs for the coming fis-
cal year;

Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §§471 and 472, as enacted by PL
1981, c. 454, §8, are repealed.

Sec. 3. 28 MRSA §474, sub-§4, as enacted by PL
1981, c. 454, §8, is amended to read:

1 4. Payment. All premiums collected by the com-
2 mission under this section shall be paid forthwith to

9 2-A. Additional information. In addition to the
10 information required by subsection 2, the commission-
11 ers shall compile information regarding payments for
12 health care of alcoholism and drug dependency treat-
13 ment paid by any nonprofit hospital or medical ser-
14 vice organization or insurer to recipients of ~~alloe-~~
15 ~~tions from the fund~~ state funding, pursuant to a
16 group contract or policy of health care coverage.
17 The commissioners shall compile this information,
18 which shall be provided by the agencies or other per-
19 sons receiving ~~these alloeations~~ state funding, show-
20 ing the amount of group health care coverage ~~moneys~~
21 money received by each agency or other person in the
22 appropriate fiscal year. This information shall be
23 submitted together with the report required by sub-
24 section 2, and may be accompanied by any specific
25 recommendations of the commissioners regarding possi-
26 ble adjustments to ~~alloeations~~ state funding, based
