7 SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
8 to H.P. 951, L.D. 1370, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand and
9 Continue Alcoholism Treatment, Education, Prevention
10 and Research Programs."

11 Amend the amendment by inserting after the title
12 the following:

13 'Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
14 the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,
15 line 23 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

16 Further amend the amendment in the first line af-
17 ter the title (page 1, line 11 in amendment) by
18 striking out the the following: "Amend" and inserting
19 in its place the following: 'Further amend'

20 Further amend the amendment by inserting after
21 the 2nd paragraph after the title the following:

22 'Sec. 2. Allocation. Upon the effective date of
23 this Act, the Commissioner of Finance and Administra-
24 tion shall certify to the State Controller, with a
25 copy to take to the Legislative Office of Fiscal and
26 Program Review, the amount of General Fund tax reve-
27 nues projected to be lost due to decreased consump-
28 tion resulting from the increase in the premium tax,
29 not to exceed \$600,000, for fiscal year 1986-87, and
30 \$300,000 for the fiscal year 1987-88.

31 The State Controller shall then transfer from the
32 Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Re-
33 search Fund to the General Fund the amount certified
34 by the commissioner in equal monthly installments.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 It is the intent of this amendment that the Gen-
3 eral Fund be reimbursed for decreases in liquor tax
4 revenue due to decreased liquor purchases resulting
5 from the increase in the premium tax. It has been
6 determined that any impact of the increase in the
7 premium tax will continue for a period not exceeding
8 18 months from the original increase in the tax.
