1 for the purpose of payment on a debt. The restitu-
2 tion contemplated by the bill is not imposed by the
3 court as a term or condition of the punishment for
4 the crime committed and thus is nothing more than the
5 collection of a debt from the inmate to the facility,
6 accordingly the conditions of the Maine Revised Stat-
7 utes, Title 14, chapter 502, should apply. The other
8 change made by this amendment is the deletion of the
9 peonage provision.


