10 11	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
12 13 14	'Emergency Preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16	Whereas, the incidence of reported child abuse has increased greatly in Maine; and
17 18 19	Whereas, the law is inadequate in that it does not allow the removal of the perpetrator from the home of the child; and
20 21 22 23	Whereas, this creates as unjust situation which may require the removal of the victim from the home, an action which reinforces the loss of worth felt by the victim and delays recovery from the trauma; and
24 25 26	Whereas, delay in correcting this will result in unnecessary suffering by individuals who have already been victimized; and
27 28 29 30 31 32	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
33 34	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

HOUSE AMENDMENT "# to H.P. 954, L.D. 1373

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1985.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency clause and emergency preamble to the bill.
