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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 961, L.D.
1382, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Municipal Regulation
of Hazardous Waste and Chemical Substances."

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Amend the bill in section 1, in subsection 3, by
striking out all of the next to the last underlined
sentence (page 1, lines 32 to 35 in L.D.) and insert-
ing in its place the following:

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'The director shall, upon request, provide a list of
hazardous chemicals in use at specific locations in a
municipality and related available information to mu-
nicipal officials of that municipality for use in the
performance of their public duties.'

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Further amend the bill in section 2, in subsec-
tion 2, in the 7th and 8th lines from the end (page
2, lines 43 and 44 in L.D.) by striking out the un-
derlined words "submitted to a" and inserting in
their place the following: 'provided by the depart-
ment to the'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear
that municipal officials may request information on
the use of hazardous chemicals only in their own mu-
nicipality and only for use in the performance of
their official duties. The amendment also makes it
clear that municipalities may request information on
hazardous wastes in their towns from the Department
of Environmental Protection.
