7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
8 to H.P. 963, L.D. 1384, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Em-
9 ployment of Certain Individuals in Contact with Chil-
10 dren."

11 Amend the amendment by striking out everything
12 after the title and inserting in its place the fol-
13 lowing:

14 'Amend the bill in section 1, by striking out all
15 of that part designated "\$2872." (page 2, lines 10 to
16 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

17 \$2872. Employees transporting minors

18 No person may be employed in any preschool or
19 school facility in any capacity which involves the
20 transporting of minors by means of motor vehicle un-
21 less the person, prior to commencement of that em-
22 ployment, submits to the facility a certified copy of
23 his driving record indicating the nature and date of
24 any adjudication or conviction for a violation of Ti-
25 tle 29, former section 1312, subsection 10; section
26 1312-B or 1312-C; or Title 15, section 3103, subsec-
27 tion 1, paragraph F, for the preceding 3-year period.
28 The copy shall be submitted prior to employment. If
29 the record indicates that such an adjudication or
30 conviction has occurred, that person may not be em-
31 ployed by the facility for the transportation of mi-
32 nors for 3 years from the date of his last convic-
33 tion, unless he has accomplished the following:

34 1. Driver Education and Evaluation Pro-
35 gram. Satisfactory completion of the Driver Educa-
36 tion and Evaluation Program of the Department of Hu-
37 man Services;

2. Substance abuse program. When required by the Secretary of State, satisfactory completion of a substance abuse treatment program or rehabilitation program approved or licensed by the Department of Human Services; and

3. After-care program. When required by the Secretary of State, attendance for 2 years at an after-care program approved by the Department of Human Services.

The employee shall pay the cost of the courses and treatments required. The person shall bear the cost of the certified copy.'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in the 5th line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the words "an affidavit" and inserting in their place the words 'certified copy of his driving record'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to require that any person employed to transport children in any day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or elementary or secondary school must submit a certified copy of his driving record showing any operating under the influence convictions during the preceding 3 years. If the record shows a conviction or adjudication of an operating under the influence, he is required to attend the driver education and evaluation program of the Department of Human Services.
