COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 963, L.D. 1384, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Employment of Certain Individuals in Contact with Children."

Amend the bill in section 1, by striking out all of that part designated "§2872." (page 2, lines 10 to 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'§2872. Employees transporting minors

No person may be employed in any preschool or school facility in any capacity which involves the transporting of minors by means of motor vehicle unless the person, prior to commencement of that employment, submits to the facility a certified copy of his driving record indicating the nature and date of any adjudication or conviction for a violation of Title 29, former section 1312, subsection 10; section 1312-B or 1312-C; or Title 15, section 3103, subsection 1, paragraph F, for the preceding 3-year period. The copy shall be submitted prior to employment. If the record indicates that such an adjudication or conviction has occurred, that person may not be employed by the facility for the transportation of minors for 3 years from the date of his last conviction. The person shall bear the cost of the certified copy.'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in the 5th line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the words "an affidavit which shall be processed in accordance with this Act" and inserting in their place the following: 'a certified copy of his driving record'

3 any person employed to transport children in any day
4 care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or ele-
5 mentary or secondary school must submit a certified
6 copy of his driving record showing convictions or ad-
7 judications concerning operating under the influence
8 during the preceding 3 years.
