COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "?" to H.P. 963, L.D.
1384, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Employment of Certain
Individuals in Contact with Children."

10 Amend the bill in section 1, by striking out all 11 of that part designated "<u>§2872.</u>" (page 2, lines 10 to 12 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

13 '§2872. Employees transporting minors

No person may be employed in any preschool or school facility in any capacity which involves the 14 15 16 transporting of minors by means of motor vehicle un-17 less the person, prior to commencement of that em-18 ployment, submits to the facility a certified copy of 19 his driving record indicating the nature and date of 20 any adjudication or conviction for a violation of Ti-21 tle 29, former section 1312, subsection 10; section 22 1312-B or 1312-C; or Title 15, section 3103, subsec-23 tion 1, paragraph F, for the preceding 3-year period. 24 The copy shall be submitted prior to employment. If 25 the record indicates that such an adjudication or conviction has occurred, that person may not be em-26 27 ployed by the facility for the transportation of minors for 3 years from the date of his last convic-tion. The person shall bear the cost of the certi-28 29 30 fied copy.

31 Further amend the bill in section 2, in the 5th 32 line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the 33 words "an affidavit which shall be processed in ac-34 cordance with this Act" and inserting in their place 35 the following: 'a certified copy of his driving 36 record'

The purpose of this amendment is to require that any person employed to transport children in any day care facility, nursery school, kindergarten or elementary or secondary school must submit a certified copy of his driving record showing convictions or adjudications concerning operating under the influence during the preceding 3 years.
