Amend the bill by adding before the Statement of Fact the following:
'Sec. 3. Application. This Act does not require the termination of an employment contract of a person employed on the effective date of this Act in any preschool or school facility in any capacity which involves the transporting of minors by means of motor vehicle.'
STATEMENT OF FACT
This amendment ensures that anyone currently employed by contract in such a capacity on the effective date of this Act is not fired. The bill still requires notification within 10 days of that person's driving record.
