SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 516, L.D. 1390, Bill, "AN ACT to Help Im-
prove the Quality of Child Care in Maine."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything
after the title and inserting in its place the fol-
lowing:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'22 MRS A §5311 is enacted to read:

§5311. Office of Child Care Coordination

1. Establishment. There is established, within
the Bureau of Social Services, the Office of Child
Care Coordination.

2. Powers and duties. The office shall have the
following powers and duties:

A. Maintain an inventory of child care informa-
tion;

B. Provide public education on becoming better
consumers of child care;

C. Evaluate prospective grantees for child care
funding grants in consultation with the Division
of Purchased and Support Service;

D. Evaluate funding methods of child care;

E. Coordinate an ongoing review of all child
care licensing rules;
