| Ę | 4406. Surplus in funds generated by ferry lines |
| | Any surplus in funds generated by each ferry line shall be placed in a separate account. These funds and the interest accrued shall be used to defray any deficit incurred by another ferry line. The balance of this surplus shall be used to reduce the passenger fare of that ferry line which generated the surplus. |
