18 AN ACT to Authorize the Use of Blue Lights on
19 Liquor Enforcement Vehicles.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 28 MRSA §1155, as repealed and replaced by PL
24 1965, c. 431, §17, is amended by adding at the end a
25 new paragraph to read:

26 Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 29, sec-
27 tions 1362 and 1368, motor vehicles operated by state
28 liquor inspectors may be equipped with sirens and
29 with lights which emit a blue beam of light, and this
30 equipment may be used only to discharge law enforce-
31 ment responsibilities in connection with this Title
32 and Title 29, sections 1312, 1312-B and 1312-C.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this new draft is to assign the
3 state liquor inspectors specific statutory authority
4 to use blue lights in law enforcement matters involv-
5 ing alcohol.

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
