18 AN ACT Validating the Vote to Convert
19 Wallagrass Plantation into the Town of
20 Wallagrass.
21

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 Sec. 1. Town of Wallagrass; incorpo-
25 rated. Wallagrass Plantation with the inhabitants
26 therein, is incorporated into a town by the name of
27 Wallagrass. The inhabitants of the town are vested
28 with the powers, privileges and immunities which the
29 inhabitants of towns within the State may enjoy. The
30 town created shall take the effects belonging to
31 Wallagrass Plantation and shall also assume all the
32 obligations of Wallagrass Plantation.

33 Sec. 2. First meeting; how called. The board of
34 assessors of the plantation shall issue their war-
35 rant, in accordance with the general laws, for an an-
36 nual meeting to be held at a time consistent with the

1 normal annual meeting time in 1986. Notification of
2 that meeting shall be filed by the plantation clerk
3 with the Secretary of State for determining the ef-
4 fective date of sections 1 and 3.

5 Sec. 3. Legislative district. Until the next
6 legislative apportionment of representatives, the
7 Town of Wallagrass shall remain in the same legisla-
8 tive district in which Wallagrass Plantation is now
9 classed.

10 Sec. 4. Effective date. The vote shall be ap-
11 proved, validated and confirmed upon certification to
12 the Secretary of State. The provisions of the vote
13 shall take effect for all purposes hereof at the
14 first town meeting in March, 1986.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This new draft eliminates the emergency provi-
17 sions of the bill. It adds the standard provisions
18 for changing a plantation to a town. It specifies
19 the effective date as the first town meeting in
20 March, 1986.
