COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 968, L.D. 1403, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Crisis Intervention and Continued Treatment and Support in Cases of Child Abuse and Neglect."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide for a Pilot Program for Treatment and Support of Incest Victims and Survivors.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
