23 SUBCHAPTER IV

24 BOARD OF OVERSEERS OF THE BAR

25 §906. Hearings; public proceedings

26 Any hearing conducted by the Board of Overseers
27 of the Bar on charges of misconduct by an attorney
28 shall be conducted as open proceedings. Any findings
29 or recommendations resulting from such a hearing
30 shall be delivered in an open proceeding.
