Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

9 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §5106, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 10 537, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§5106. Forest Resource Assessment and Marketing Program

There is created within the Department of Conservation, a Forest Resource Assessment and Marketing Program for the purpose of assisting the department in fulfilling its responsibilities under this chapter, to otherwise cause studies to be conducted to assess market factors significant to the forest industry, to receive, process and analyze data obtained from the United States Forest Service Decennial Forest Resurvey and other sources and to establish marketing and utilization programs, including, but not limited to, programs to develop expanded export markets, encourage increased use of under utilized species, promote in-state secondary and value-added processing of Maine wood and paper products and pursuing additional markets for fuel wood and wood chips.

Sec. 2. Public Law 1983, c. 537, §2 is repealed.
