14 15 16	IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
17 18 19	AN ACT to Provide for a Law Enforcement Telecommunications System.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	25 MRSA §1508 is enacted to read:
23	§1508. Law Enforcement Telecommunications System
24 25 26 27 28 29	The Bureau of the State Police may provide for installation, operation and maintenance of a Law En- forcement Telecommunications System for the purpose of promptly collecting, exchanging and distributing information relating to police problems of the State, counties, cities and towns.
30 31 32 33 34	The system may be connected, directly or indi- rectly, with similar systems in other states or the Federal Government. The Chief of the State Police shall provide for the location of the central pro- cessing system and lines. The state departments and

agencies, counties, cities and towns shall provide, at their own expense, the terminals, modems and for the personnel and supplies for their proper operation.

The system shall be installed, operated and main-5 6 tained in accordance with the rules adopted by the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System, 7 the National Crime Information Center and the Chief 8 9 of the State Police or his designee. The character of the communications sent and the time, place and 10 manner of sending messages and all matters connnected 11 12 with the system shall be under the control and man-13 agement of the Chief of the State Police or his des-14 ignee.

16 The purpose of this bill is to provide for uni-17 formity in the Law Enforcement Telecommunications 18 System within the State and to comply with the Na-19 tional Crime Information Center and the National Law 20 Enforcement Telecommunications System user agree-21 ments.
