17 AN ACT to Make Survivors Benefits Mandatory
18 for any Member of the Maine State Retirement
19 System.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1092, sub-§13, as amended by PL
24 1977, c. 700, §2, is repealed and the following en-
25 acted in its place:

26 13. Survivor benefits. The survivor's contribu-
27 tion of a participating local district shall be actu-
28 arially determined annually by the board of trustees
29 on the basis of such information which it may pre-
30 scribe.

31 The board of trustees may increase by not more than
32 25% in any year the survivor's contribution of a par-
33 ticipating local district so determined if, in the
34 opinion of the board of trustees, the actual experi-
35 ence as to benefits paid on behalf of beneficiaries
