4 The contributions so computed, together with a pro rata share of the cost of the administration of the 5 6 survivor's benefit program, based upon the gross pay-7 roll of employees and the expense of determining the annual survivor's contribution shall be certified by 8 9 the board of trustees to the chief fiscal officer of 10 the participating local district, and the amounts so 11 certified shall be a charge against the participating 12 local district.

All survivor contributions by such participating lo cal districts shall be paid into the Survivors' Bene fit Fund.

16 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §1124, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 17 1983, c. 53, is repealed and the following enacted 18 in its place:

19 <u>5.</u> Applicability. This section shall apply to
