AN ACT Requiring the Department of  
Educational and Cultural Services to  
Establish Models for Evaluating  
Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §13802 is enacted to read:

§13802. Teacher evaluation models

1. Department to establish models. The department shall establish models for evaluation of the professional performance of teachers employed in any school administrative unit within the State.

2. Use of models. Each school administrative unit within the State shall have the option to incorporate the models developed pursuant to subsection 1

1 for the evaluation of the professional performance of  
2 any teacher employed by that school administrative  
3 unit.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this new draft is to require the  
6 Department of Educational and Cultural Services to  
7 establish evaluation models which may be used by  
8 school administrative units in the evaluation of  
9 teacher performance.

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
