In recent negotiations between hospitals and nurses, the hospitals have taken the position that the wage factor established by the Health Care Finance Commission is the maximum allowable increase in wages, including normal career ladder step increases. In reality, the commission merely establishes a "proxie" for the increase in costs of services as one of many factors reflecting the projected impact of inflation on hospital costs. The individual proxie is only important as part of the entire financial circumstances in containing hospital costs and is not related to any individual wage settlement. This bill makes it clear that the health care cost containment legislation was not intended to substitute for the collective bargaining process.
