Resolved: That there is 14 established the Study Commission on Government Compe-15 tition with Private Enterprise to consist of 11 mem-16 bers: The Commissioner of Finance and Administration; 17 the Director of the Bureau of Purchases; the Commissioner of Personnel; the Director of the State Devel-18 19 opment Office; the Commissioner of Transportation; and 6 members of the public of which at least 4 shall 20 21 be engaged in private enterprise and 2 shall have ex-22 perience in cost accounting, to be appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall designate one of the 23 24 public members as chairman; and be it further 25 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the 5th paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following: 26 27 28 '3. The estimated dollar value of and both the 29 direct and indirect costs of goods and services pro-30 vided by the State to its own agencies or the public 31 in competition with the private sector;

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Further amend the resolve in the first paragraph before the Statement of Fact in the last line (page 3, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following "compensation." and inserting in its place the following ', but shall be reimbursed for expenses in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 379, for a maximum of 12 meetings; and be it COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 996, L.D. 1433 1 further' 2 Further amend the resolve by inserting before the 3 Statement of Fact the following: 4 'Staff. Resolved: That the Department of Finance 5 and Administration shall provide for the staffing of 6 the commission. 7 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-8 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes 9 of this resolve. 10 1985-86 1986-87 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, 11 12 DEPARTMENT OF 13 \$4,050 All Other \$2,700 14 FISCAL NOTE 15 This resolve will incur a cost \$6,750 to the Gen-16 eral Fund.' 17 STATEMENT OF FACT 18 This amendment makes some technical changes. It requires the commission to include 2 members with cost accounting experience and to study the direct 19 20 21 and indirect costs of providing government services and goods. In addition, this amendment requires the Department of Finance and Administration to staff the 22 23 24 commission. The appropriation provides funds for the 25 payment of expenses for commission members from the 26 general public and private sector. 3847052385 27
