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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 996, L.D. 1433, "Resolve, to Establish a Study Commission on Government Competition with Private Enterprise."

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Amend the resolve by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

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'Commission established. Resolved: That there is established the Study Commission on Government Competition with Private Enterprise to consist of 11 members: The Commissioner of Finance and Administration; the Director of the Bureau of Purchases; the Commissioner of Personnel; the Director of the State Development Office; the Commissioner of Transportation; and 6 members of the public of which at least 4 shall be engaged in private enterprise and 2 shall have experience in cost accounting, to be appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall designate one of the public members as chairman; and be it further'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the 5th paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

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'3. The estimated dollar value of and both the direct and indirect costs of goods and services provided by the State to its own agencies or the public in competition with the private sector;'

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Further amend the resolve in the first paragraph before the Statement of Fact in the last line (page 3, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following "compensation." and inserting in its place the following ', but shall be reimbursed for expenses in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 379, for a maximum of 12 meetings; and be it

2 Further amend the resolve by inserting before the
3 Statement of Fact the following:

4 'Staff. Resolved: That the Department of Finance
5 and Administration shall provide for the staffing of
6 the commission.

7 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
8 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
9 of this resolve.

15 This resolve will incur a cost \$6,750 to the Gen-

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment makes some technical changes. It
19 requires the commission to include 2 members with
20 cost accounting experience and to study the direct
21 and indirect costs of providing government services
22 and goods. In addition, this amendment requires the
23 Department of Finance and Administration to staff the
24 commission. The appropriation provides funds for the
25 payment of expenses for commission members from the
26 general public and private sector.
