17 18 19 20	Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated "§22.", in subsection 3, by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 3, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.)
21 22 23	Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated " $\S22$.", by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

15	STATEMENT OF FACT
16 17 18 19 20 21	This amendment makes 2 technical corrections and authorizes heads of departments and members of boards and commissions to solicit political contributions except from state employees in the department or agencies in which the department head or board member is employed or affiliated.
22 23 24 25	The technical corrections correct an erroneous statutory reference and repeal a provision of law that is in conflict with the bill and which the bill replaces.
