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SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 535, L.D. 1436,
Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Department of Human Ser-
vices to Investigate and Provide Information on Com-
munity Health Issues."

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Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part desig-
nated "§1969-D." by inserting after the first para-
graph the following paragraph:

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'In the case of a request for information from a
municipality or individual concerning chemicals in
use or present at a specific site, the director shall
be required to provide information pursuant to this
Act only if the specific site is within a 50-mile ra-
dius of the municipality or within a 50-mile radius
of a residence of the individual requesting the in-
formation.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to limit re-
quests from municipalities and individuals to those
concerning sites within a 50-mile radius.
