	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2205 is amended to read:
	§2205 endorsement
	The board may shall issue a license to practice professional nursing as a registered professional nurse by endorsement to an applicant who has been duly licensed by examination as a registered nurse under the laws of another state, territory or foreign country, if in the opinion of the board the applicant meets the qualifications required of registered nurses in this State at the time of graduation.
	Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §2254 is amended to read:

§2254. -- endorsement

The board may shall issue a license to practice as a licensed practical nurse by endorsement to any applicant who has been duly licensed or registered as a licensed practical nurse or a person entitled to perform similar services under a different title, under laws of another state, territory or foreign country, if in the opinion of the board the applicant meets the requirements for licensed practical nurses in this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The State Board of Nursing has the authority to issue licenses to professional nurses and practical nurses following examination. The current law also allows the board to grant a license to a nurse who has been licensed in another state, territory or country. This bill requires the board to issue a Maine license when the nurse has been duly licensed by examination in another jurisdiction.
