Amend the bill in the first paragraph after the amending clause in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 29 and 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation" and inserting in its place the following: 'Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation 'Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation Game Warden Colonel in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife'
18 STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this amendment is to replace the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy with the Game Warden Colonel of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Since the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation is now separate from the Department of Corrections, it is not necessary to include the former department on the board of a law enforcement educational institution.
