18 AN ACT Relating to Membership on the Board of
19 Trustees of the Criminal Justice
20 Academy.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 25 MRSA §2802, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c.
25 493, §§2 and 3, is further amended to read:

26 There is created a board of trustees for the
27 academy consisting of ~~13~~ 15 members as follows: The
28 Commissioner of Public Safety, ex officio, the Attor-
29 ney General, ex officio, the Commissioner of Mental
30 Health and Mental Retardation and the Commissioner of
31 Corrections, ex officio, and the following to be ap-
32 pointed by the Governor: A commissioned officer of
33 the State Police, a county sheriff, a chief of a mu-
34 nicipal police department, 2 officers of municipal
35 police departments, an educator, a representative
36 from a criminal justice agency not involved in the

1 general enforcement of Maine criminal laws, a repre-
2 sentative of a federal law enforcement agency, a citi-
3 zen and, a municipal officer and one nonsupervisory
4 corrections officer representing a state or county
5 correctional facility.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This new draft provides for one additional member
8 to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Jus-
9 tice Academy. Unlike the original bill which adds 2
10 nonsupervisory corrections officers representing
11 state and county correctional facilities, this new
12 draft adds only one nonsupervisory corrections offi-
13 cer who may represent either a state or county cor-
14 rectional facility.
