18 AN ACT to Establish a Funding Mechanism to
19 Make the Joint Environmental Training
20 Program Self-supporting.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 32 MRSA §4173-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983,
25 c. 832, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in
26 its place:

27 3. Self supporting. This program shall be self-
28 supporting from fees, grants or other sources of rev-
29 enue not including the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This new draft makes it clear that the program
3 can become self-supporting by charging fees, accept-
4 ing grants and other sources of revenue that may be
5 available for these purposes. The General Fund is
6 specifically excluded as a source of funding. The
7 new draft also deletes an obsolete reporting require-
8 ment which has been satisfied.

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
