	AN ACT to Establish a Funding Mechanism to Make the Joint Environmental Training Program Self-supporting.
	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	32 MRSA §4173-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 832, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
	3. Self supporting. This program shall be self-supporting from fees, grants or other sources of revenue not including the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft makes it clear that the program can become self-supporting by charging fees, accepting grants and other sources of revenue that may be available for these purposes. The General Fund is specifically excluded as a source of funding. The new draft also deletes an obsolete reporting requirement which has been satisfied.

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
