15	2-A. Prior to a hearing on any plan or procedure
16	under this section, the superintendent shall appoint
17	an advocate for the insurer's policyholders. The ad-
18	vocate shall be given access to the insurer's list of
19	policyholders and shall be afforded sufficient time
20	prior to any hearing to distribute information to the
21	insurer's policyholders. Any costs related to repro-
22	duction of any lists or any information for the lists
23	and the distribution of any information shall be in-
24	cluded in the advocate's budget as set out in para-
25	graph B.
26	A. The advocate may retain counsel and may hire
27	actuaries as he deems necessary to carry out his
