Any person who will be 16 years of age or older at the beginning of the special season in subsection 4, may obtain a muzzle-loading license from the commissioner or his authorized agent, provided that that person possesses a valid license to hunt big game. 17	muzzle-loading open season on deer on the Monday to

22	essary due to adverse weather conditions or severe
23	hunting pressure.
24	5. Restrictions. The following restrictions ap-
25	ply during the muzzle-loading open season.
26	A. The open season shall be limited to the tak-
