STATEMENT OF FACT

Current law is unclear on what the Acquisition Fund may be used for. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 4169, subsection 3, provides that money in the Acquisition Fund must be used exclusively to purchase and assemble quantities of land. The law also states that the funds may be used to pay for the purchase of real property, rights-of-way and rights in land other than ownership. Real property is a broader term and arguably includes rights in land besides ownership, such as rights-of-way.

The Bureau of Public Lands is currently using the broader interpretation to purchase rights-of-way so that timber can be harvested on public lots.
