COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 572, L.D. 1507

It provides an appropriation of \$200,000 each year from the General Fund to be used to implement this service system, within the limits of the available resources. It also permits the Bureau of Rehabilitation to accept gifts to assist in carrying out its responsibilities under the Independent Living Service for Severely Disabled Persons law. |
