18 19 20	AN ACT to Establish Temporary Handicapped Parking Permits.
21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	29 MRSA §252-C is enacted to read:
24	§252-C Temporary handicapped placards
25 26 27 28 29	Upon request from a person seeking a temporary handicapped placard, the physician may prepare a pre- scription request upon which shall appear the person's name and an assigned expiration date speci- fied by the physician.
30 31 32 33 34	Persons granted prescription requests from their physicians may then send or present in person this document to an office administered by the Division of Motor Vehicles for issuance of a temporary handi- capped placard. The Division of Motor Vehicles will

1	give priority consideration to these requests.	А	\$1
2	fee shall be charged for each placard issued.	_	

3	Temporary handicapped placards shall be of a de-
4	sign established by the Secretary of State and the
5	placards will show the expiration date specified by
6	the physician who prepared the prescription request.

7 Any temporary placard issued under this section may be displayed in any motor vehicle which the hand-8 9 icapped person to whom the placard was provided is operating, in which he is a passenger, in which he is 10 11 being transported or in which he is waiting for a 12 service to be rendered. The temporary placard shall be so affixed that the information on the placard is 13 14 clearly legible from outside the motor vehicle.

15 A person to whom a temporary placard has been is-16 sued under this section is entitled to the same 17 rights and privileges as a person to whom a plate or 18 placard is issued under section 252, during the term 19 of that temporary placard.
