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STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This new draft raises the competitive bidding 12 minimum for county purchases through the State to the 13 level of other county purchases. It affirms that such 14 minimums on purchases through the State are subject 15 to the approval of the State. It makes it clear that 16 county competitive bidding shall be conducted by the 17 same procedures as are required for state purchases.

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
