21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 24	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §472, sub-§12-A is enacted to read:
25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32	12-A. Physically handicapped person. "Physically handicapped person" means a person who has a physiological disability, infirmity, malformation, disfigurement or condition which eliminates or severely limits the person's ability to have access to his environment by normal ambulatory function, thereby necessitating the use of crutches, a wheelchair or other similar device for locomotion.
33 34	Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §475, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c. 168, §26, is further amended to read:

The board shall consist of 9 members, of whom 7 6 shall be appointed to membership by the director, subject to the approval of the Governor. Each member shall hold office until his successor is duly appointed. At the expiration of each member's term, his successor shall be appointed by the director, subject to the approval of the Governor, from the same classification in accordance with this section for a term of 4 years. In case of a vacancy in board membership, the director, with the approval of the Governor, shall appoint a member of the proper classification serve the term of the absent member. Of the 7 appeinted 6 members of the board, appointed by the director, one shall be representative of owners or lessees of elevators within the State; one shall be a representative of manufacturers of elevators; shall be a representative of insurance companies lieensed to insure elevators and tramways in the State; one shall be a licensed elevator mechanic; one shall a representative of a ski area operator presently operating tramways in the State; one shall be a qualified licensed professional engineer, who is familiar with tramway design, inspection and operation; be a representative of the skiing public shall who regularly uses tramways public member. The 7th member of the board shall be a physically handicapped person appointed by the Director of the Bureau of Rehabilitation, subject to the approval of the Governor, for a term of 4 years. The 8th member shall be a member of the Division of Fire Prevention appointed by the Commissioner of Public Safety and the 9th member of the board shall be the rector of the Bureau of Labor Standard Standards, who shall be chairman of the board.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft removes the board member who is a representative of insurance companies, adds a member who is a physically handicapped person and changes the public member's position from a person who is a representative of the skiing public to a person who is a public member.

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
