2	This new draft reduces the annual inspection fee
3	for inclined lifts and vertical lifts for use by the
4	handicapped or disabled from the current \$30 to \$20.
5	Many public buildings now provide these "stairglides"
6	to assist handicapped, disabled and elderly people
7	who are not able to climb flights of stairs. This re-
8	duction in fees addresses the costs that can result
9	to houses of worship and other nonprofit groups that
10	install more than one such lift.

The initial inspection fee for a newly installed lift remains the same.

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
