does not apply to special agency stores licensed un-  
der this section.'



The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that  
the 10-mile spacing distance which applies to all  
other agency stores does not apply to the seasonal

1 net increase to the General Fund of \$650,000. This  
2 is based on current operating conditions and estimat-  
3 ing that the new stores will bring in \$1,600,000 in  
4 new sales annually. Forty percent will accrue to the  
5 General Fund. This increase will not be present un-  
6 til fiscal year 1987 because of the start-up time  
7 necessary. Revenue in fiscal year 1986 will be mini-
