26	STATEMENT OF FACT
27	The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that
28 29	the 10-mile spacing distance which applies to all other agency stores does not apply to the seasonal
30	stores licensed under this section. It is estimated
31 32	that if all 6 seasonal stores are opened for a 6-month period from May to October, there will be a

1 net increase to the General Fund of \$650,000. This 2 is based on current operating conditions and estimat-3 ing that the new stores will bring in \$1,600,000 in 4 new sales annually. Forty percent will accrue to the 5 General Fund. This increase will not be present un-6 til fiscal year 1987 because of the start-up time 7 necessary. Revenue in fiscal year 1986 will be mini-8 mal.
